

Photoshop Notes

1. Brighten Eyes and Colour

Colour Change or enhance

- a. Select Quick Mask – change default to show selected area
- b. **Selective colour** - Adjustment Layer Blend mode **Linear Dodge**
- c. Colour select neutrals
- d. Adjust cyan and magenta

Contrast

- a. On **selective colour** adjustment layer
- b. Change to black
- c. Use black slider to adjust contrast.

2. Dodge and Burn Local Contrast Highlights and Shadows

- a. 50% Grey layer
- b. Blend mode - Soft light
- c. Dodge and burn tools 10% - Protect tones
- d. Correct using 50% grey with paint brush if needed.

3. Colour LOOK UP Tables 3D LUT

- a. Load 3D CLUT as Adjustment Layer
- b. Tension Green 30%
- c. Edgy Amber 20%
- d. Foggy Night 20%
- e. Put into Group
